With a large area of land, our vineyards are located on the sunny slopes of Córgomo, Villamartín de Valdeorras; where the highest and lowest temperatures in all of Galicia are recorded, as well as the lowest rainfall in the region. This guarantees, together with the significant day / night thermal jumps, a good acidity for white wines, accompanied by slate soils, which provide the marked mineral character of the godellos.

The winery is equipped with the latest oenological technologies, where by applying new production techniques, together with technology and family tradition, we obtain these magnificent Godello and Mencía wines.
